



2025 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP POINT SCORE REGULATIONS

1. Financial membership of CHKRC must be in place at each round. All financial members can accumulate points in the CHKRC Championship at each eligible race meeting.
2. Points are awarded across 6 championship rounds as advised in the CHKRC calendar. The driver's best 5 rounds for the year will be recorded for their corrected points over the championship rounds. This will allow members the ability to drop or miss a round whilst still having the ability to compete in the championship.
3. If the published number of rounds cannot be run, championship points will be awarded across the number of rounds run and 1 round will still be dropped.
4. If a draw of points occur in the corrected points at the end of the championship, the member with higher overall points (dropped round points added back in) will be considered the winner of that championship. If still drawn the competitor that raced against the most competitors (in their point scoring class) will be considered the winner.
5. Points will be awarded as per the table on the point score spreadsheet and encourages competitors to be part of a well-attended class. Points will be awarded for a driver's finish position as determined by the results of the meeting (non-club members will not be removed from results).
6. For a member to be eligible for the class championship or club champion, each member must dedicate one FULL day's work to the club+ TWO full working bee days. Parents, friends or guardians may work on behalf of any driver by simply nominating their efforts to the driver when completing their duties. The recognition of one day's work will be at the sole discretion of the Club President and a deadline of the date of the final round to be run in 2025 shall apply. Individuals may work on more than one day and may work on behalf of more than one driver.

7. Bonus points can be obtained by the following means:-

- Additional **FIVE** Club Championship points will be allocated for Volunteer and Working Bee days up to a maximum of **TWENTY** additional points.
- Volunteer days at AKC Round will attract double points.

8. The individual must have raced a minimum of 4 CHKRC Club Championship events to qualify for the overall championship points. This can be any class in the relevant age group (Cadet, Junior, and Senior). Points may not be taken from one age group to another.

9. The member must have raced in a minimum of 4 of the 6 CHKRC Club Championship rounds in a class to qualify for that class championship.

10. A class must have had a minimum of 3 entrants face the starter at a minimum of 4 rounds to qualify for class points, points will still be awarded for overall championship (at 50% as per rule 11).

11. Where there are less than 3 starters in a class, 50% of the normally allocated points will be allocated to each driver for both the Class and Club Championships as per the points table.

12. You must advise of errors to the point system prior to the next club meeting. **NO** changes will be made after this point in time.

13. Trophies will be awarded to the winners in each eligible Club Championship class.

14. Club Champion trophy will be awarded to best placed member in overall point score, points can be accumulated from more than one (1) class, however if you run 2 classes at the 1 round the highest point scoring class will be used. Club Champion will receive Club Champion Trophy, Club Champion perpetual Club Trophy as well as FREE Club Membership in 2026.
